



JOB DESCRIPTION – Volunteer Counsellors

The work involved is to undertake Counselling sessions on a one-to-one basis with adults who have been sexually abused as children. At present the commitment is once a fortnight for a one hour counselling session. One hour of Supervision follows counselling sessions, alternating between the peer group of counsellors and facilitated supervision with an experienced supervisor.

You are expected to abide by the Aims and Objectives of SEREN and will be answerable to the Executive Committee.

You are expected to abide by the BACP ethical framework.

Previous experience in counselling is essential. SEREN provides induction training and continuing professional development related to this field.

Any expenses in connection with this voluntary work will be paid by SEREN – e.g. travel and childcare expenses.

Volunteer counsellors who are on student placement must be in their 2nd year of a counselling diploma course, and have had some face-to-face counselling experience.
